Both TITANUS® aspirating smoke detectors and smoke switches (multi-criteria detectors) with SIL and without SIL certifications are suitable for this purpose. "InnoTrans is the meeting place for the rail community. We look forward to numerous personal discussions and opportunities to exchange information about our innovative solutions, such as our TITANUS® C-Pro series with a hose system specially adapted for rail transport. Visitors to the trade show will also learn how our solutions work in practice from our reference projects," Dr. Müller continues. These include, for example, the SOB Traverso, which runs the picturesque Gotthard route between Switzerland and Italy, the long-distance trains of Czech Railways and the new KISS SBB double-decker trains.

In addition, WAGNER Rail develops and installs solutions for firefighting with water mist as well as fire extinguishing with aerosol and inert gases for various types of rail vehicles. In doing so, the fire protection expert always works in accordance with the latest European and worldwide standards, such as the recently revised UNI 11565:2021, which is responsible for Italy.
